



## FIP-IFP Awards

The FIP-IFP feels it is of utmost importance to support and recognize individuals who, through their vision and commitment to their profession, are making outstanding contributions to the fields of podiatric practice. As such, each year FIP-IFP honors those who have demonstrated commendable work and dedication in areas which parallel the overall FIP-IFP mission.

The FIP-IFP awards should be submitted 30 days before the AGM to the President and the Executive Director (director@fip-ifp.org) with a letter of support and the nomination form. All applications will be reviewed by the FIP-IFP Executive Board.

Four recognitions can be awarded:

- the FIP-IFP Lifetime Achievement Award,
- the FIP-IFP Distinguished Service Award,
- the FIP-IFP Humanitarian Award and

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## FIP-IFP LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD Criteria

The FIP-IFP Lifetime Achievement Award can be awarded annually to an individual person involved within an FIP-IFP member or corporate partner who meets one or more of the criteria, is nominated by a peer or colleague and is selected by the FIP-IFP Board.

### Award Criteria

- an individual person involved within an FIP-IFP member or Partner who is recognized for his or her **lifelong commitment and contribution** to the development and promotion of podiatry around the world.
- an individual person involved within an FIP-IFP member or Partner who has contributed through innovation, technology, research, data outcomes, analysis etc.

### Award process

The FIP-IFP Lifetime Achievement Award, shall be presented each year at the AGM or during the World Congress in the form of a certificate signed by the FIP-IFP President and a commemorative.

## FIP-IFP DISTINGUISHED SERVICE AWARD Criteria

The FIP-IFP Distinguished Service Award will be awarded annually to an individual person involved within a FIP-IFP member or corporate partner who meets one or more of the criteria, is nominated by a peer or colleague and is selected by the FIP-IFP Board.

### Award Criteria

- FIP-IFP member or Partner who is recognized for his or her outstanding service to the profession and our organization as a Board member, Committee Chair or Organizational Partner
- FIP-IFP member or Partner who is recognized for his or her commitment and contribution to the development and promotion of podiatry around the world

### Award process

The FIP-IFP Distinguished Service Award, shall be presented each year at the AGM in the form of a certificate signed by the FIP-IFP President, together with a gold ribbon for persons inside the profession. Distinguished Service award outside the profession gets a Blue Ribbon. FIP-IFP Board members who have served the International Federation of Podiatrists and are at the end of their term receive a red ribbon.

## FIP-IFP HUMANITARIAN AWARD Criteria

The FIP-IFP Humanitarian Award will be awarded annually to an individual person involved within an FIP-IFP member country or corporate partner who meets one or more of the criteria, is nominated by a peer or colleague and is selected by the FIP-IFP Board.

### Award Criteria

- Individual with a long-term commitment to humanitarian aid and disaster relief for their country of origin or internationally.
- Individual who has contributed to international Podiatry education and training in developing countries.
- Individual who has made a substantial contribution or a unique sacrifice to serve others in their community in their country of origin or internationally.
- Individual who has contributed to the humanitarian aid disaster relief community through innovation, technology, research, data outcomes, analysis etc.

### Award process

The FIP-IFP Humanitarian Award, shall be presented each year at the AGM in the form of a gift signed by the FIP-IFP President. An award of 500 EUR shall be donated to a charity of the recipients' choice.
